



Thank you for your registration to participate in Christikon's special adult session.  
Information on camp:

1. **Health History Online.** It is very important for us to have this on file for each person at camp; and we need to have it **no later than May 28**, so our staff may have sufficient time to plan for adequate health care. The form complies with accreditation standards of the American Camp Association. Each person should have been examined by a physician within the last twenty-four months prior to arrival at camp. A copy of a Special Olympics Physical is acceptable if dated within 24 months of coming to camp). **Medications, nature of assistance needed** and any dietary needs or restrictions should be entered into the health form.
2. **Bus transportation** information is available to download. The transportation fee is in addition to the camp fee.
3. **Registration begins** at 4:00 p.m. on **the first day of camp**. The first meal served is supper that day. The **session ends** by 9:00 a.m. on **the last day of camp**. Rides for campers not using the bus should be at camp by that time.
4. **Medications** brought to camp by participants should be in the **original bottles or containers** that have on them the physician/pharmacy instructions for dispensing. (Accurate and full medication information should also have been included on the camper health form.) You will receive a gallon bag identified with your name to place your medications prior to camp. These bags will be placed in a box going directly to the Health Manager at camp. **Do not pack in your luggage. Give the bag to the bus attendant.**
5. **What to bring:** Warm sleeping bag or other bedding, casual clothing, a warm jacket, comfortable shoes, towel, and toilet articles. **Please mark sleeping bags, pillows, jackets and suitcases with each camper's name**, to help us get things properly distributed upon arrival at camp.
6. **What NOT to bring:** Music players and radios, dress clothes, pets, firearms or fireworks. Smoking may be done only at designated locations and times.
7. Each camper will receive a t-shirt included in the registration fee. Please provide your campers size. If they are wanting a hoodie (sweatshirt) the cost is \$40.
8. **If a camper is unable to attend**, please notify us in advance. Advance notice qualifies for refund of fees (see the Statement), and permits us to admit individuals who are on our waiting list.
